

General Information

The seedbanks and seed collectors listed here supply seed of local native (indigenous) trees, shrubs and other plants for use in the revegetation of farms, roadsides and other land in various regions of rural Victoria.

The list has been prepared based on information provided by the seedbanks and collectors themselves. Greening Australia cannot accept responsibility for the conduct of any seedbank or collector listed.

Greening Australia encourages and recommends, wherever possible, the use of seed collected from local native plants in revegetation projects. The adaptations of these plants over many thousands of years to local conditions (such as soils and climate) means that, with good site preparation, they are likely to grow successfully and provide multiple benefits. These adaptations include co-evolution with our native fauna so that our animals depend on our plants, eg. food, nest sites, shelter, and our plants depend on our animals, eg. pollinators.

However, we recognise that, in certain circumstances, site conditions may be extensively modified or indigenous species may not meet the objectives of the revegetation, eg. specific non-local seed for farm forestry. A number of the collectors and seedbanks listed here can provide seed for these special purposes.

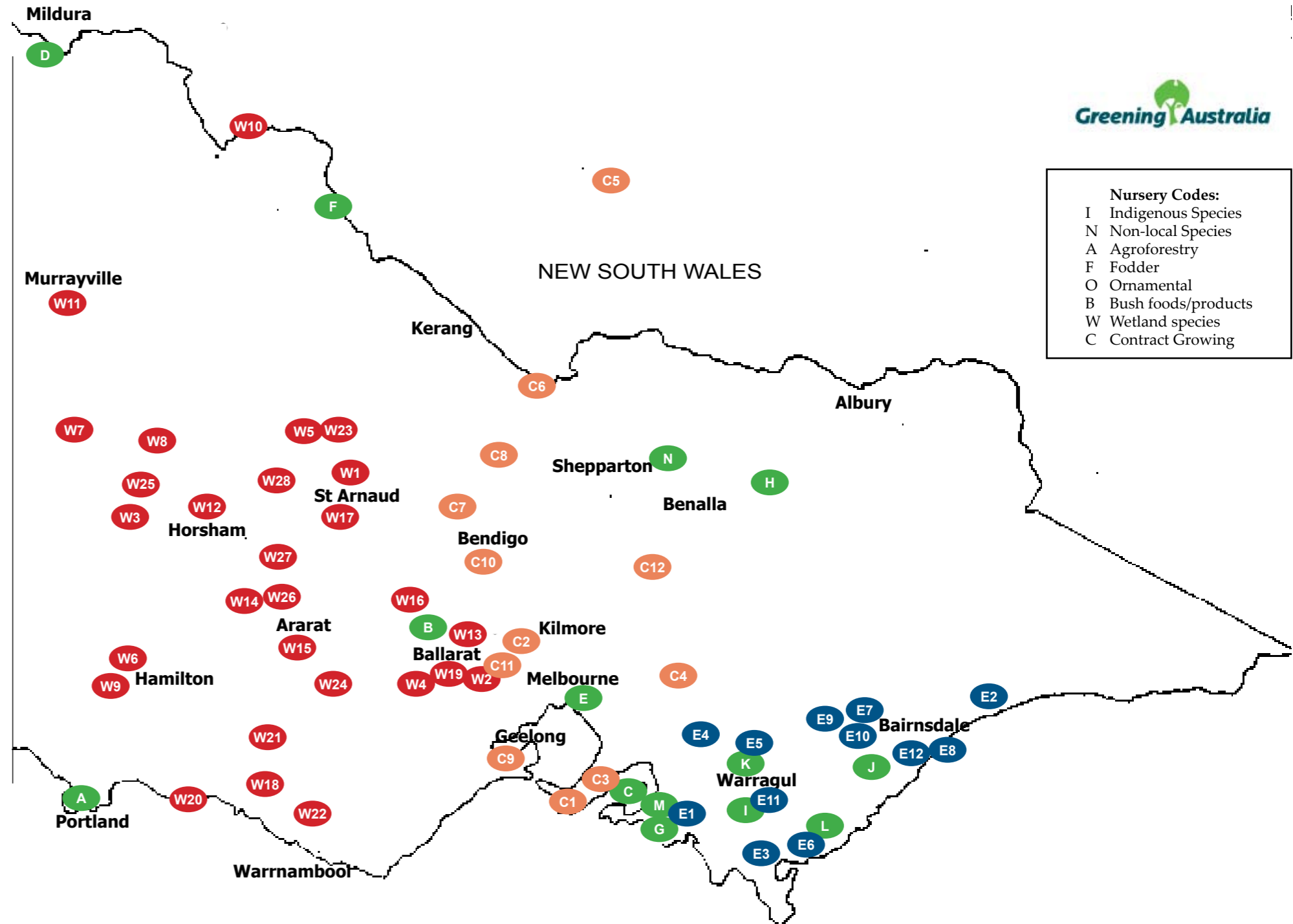
When purchasing seed, ask the suppliers for details of seed source including precise location, year of collection and number of trees and shrubs sampled. Seedbanks and collectors can generally arrange for collection of seed not in stock.

Greening Australia encourages the responsible collection of seed from remnant native plants found in your local area. Permits to collect native seed from public land are required from the Department of Sustainability and Environment (DSE).
