From Wetlands, to coastal zones, to the Mt Lofty Ranges and across regional South Australia we can deliver species to suit every South Australian landscape.

With experienced staff on hand to advise and assist you, we propagate a comprehensive range of local native plant stock. Whether you require plant material grown from seed or cuttings, we ensure the stock you receive is tailored to your project needs. Container types available include colmax cells, Hiko trays, round and square tubes in various sizes. We also grow in larger pot sizes between 140mm and 50L.

Foam Box Seed Orchards

The Greening Australia Nursery team understand the amount of work involved in collecting and propagating rare or hard to grow species. As a response to this we have developed a foam box seed orchard method which ensures these species can be grown year after year.

By using this method, we aim to have species readily available for planting by the end of the first year. As part of this seed production area we create a seedbank for future years and longer-term projects.



Seed Management and Storage

Greening Australia maintains a seed bank containing many hundreds of South Australian plant species.

Our trained and experienced staff are licenced to collect Native Seed by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources and comply with national Florabank standards.

Services include:

- Specialised seed collection to match your provenance needs
- Seed supply from our comprehensive on-site seed bank
- Storage and maintenance of your own seed stock under controlled conditions

Plant Rescue and Relocation

Native plant rescue involves the removal of rare and endangered native plants from any environment/s that is to be disturbed or destroyed. Rescued plants are potted up and maintained in our nursery until they can be transplanted into safe, natural environments or replanted on the original site once the disturbance has passed. Greening Australia worked with the Department for Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (SA) to rescue vegetation at a number of sites including major upgrading of road and rail corridors.

Native Nursery 6 Packs

In response to the wider community's demand for native plants in a suburban setting, Greening Australia has produced a Backyard Biodiversity native plant 6-pack, suitable for use in Adelaide's backyards.

These 6 packs make an ideal present or corporate gift for any occasion. The 6-packs may be purchased in bulk for specific fundraising or promotional projects. A mix of native plant species, tailored to your requirements, will be supplied.

Planning Ahead

Australian natives often require considerably more time to propagate than non-native species. This means that you need to plan well in advance if you want good quality stock, ready to plant out. Typically, you must allow a minimum of 6 months between placing an order and receiving your stock, longer in some cases, depending on your species selection.

Also, critical to your planning stage is recognition that many species will only germinate during a particular time of year. You can use the information below as a guide to when you should be ordering for your next project. If the species you are interested in is not on the list, just give us a call and we will give you a specific timeline.

Nursery Orders

Bulk stock order minimum = 1000 seedlings. Lesser amounts may be agreed by negotiation. Order placement must allow adequate germination, cutting development and growth times.

<p>Winter Warmers - order by September These species require cold temperatures to stimulate germination;</p> <p>Banksia, Callitris, Bursaria, Pittosporum, Austrostipa, Arthropodium, Hakea, Olearia, Dianella, Clematis, Gahnia.</p>	<p>Spring Species order - by October Many of our local natives love the spring weather especially when the soil is still moist;</p> <p>Eucalyptus, Melaleuca, Acacia, Allocasuarina, Leptospermum, Kennedia, Hardenbergia, Eutaxia, Vittadinia, Schoenoplectus, Maireana aphylla.</p>
<p>Summer Lovers - order by November Requiring the hot conditions of summer to germinate and grow to a suitable size;</p> <p>Austrodanthonia, Chloris, Enneapogon, Cyperes, Enchylaena, Atriplex, Themeda, Poa, Phragmites, Carex, Juncus, Isolepis, Maireana.</p>	<p>Long Term Projects Many plant species take longer than 12 months to be supplied from the date of order. Some can require up to two years if they are a specialised genus such as;</p> <p>Xanthorrhoea, Lomandra, Leucopogon, Lepidosperma, Santalum.</p>
